History of the Bible Institute of South Africa 1923 - 1973

THIS year the Bible Institute of South Africa is celebrating its 50th Anniversary. It opened as a full-time training Institute on April 9th, 1923. Only two students were enrolled at the time. Since then the work has continued to grow and this year 65 students are enrolled, the largest number ever to attend.

ORIGINS

The Bible Institute owes its origin to the concern that was felt by Evangelicals in all denominations over the drift towards liberal theology and modernism which prevailed in the theological seminaries. After the first world war certain Methodist ministers took action and planned to endow a chair of evangelical theology at one of the South African Universities. The authorities of the University were favourable to this plan. However, this was the era when
